

TRIP ITINERARY

DAY 1

Arrival Bangkok

Upon arrival at the Bangkok airport and after the immigration formalities you're met by our representative.

Board a vehicle and transfer to the hotel.

Check-in at the hotel and rest of the day is at leisure.

Overnight: Bangkok

DAY 2

BKK city tour Grand Palace, Reclining Buddha, Wat Arun, Golden Buddha,

You begin your sightseeing excursion after breakfast at the hotel.

Your journey will begin at two of Bangkok's most famous tourist attractions: the Royal Grand Palace and the Emerald Buddha.

The Grand Palace shares a complex with Wat Pho Kaew and is where you will end up after leaving Wat Phra Kaew.

Despite their close proximity, there is a clear difference in style between the distinctly Thai Wat Pho Kaew and the more European-inspired buildings, with the exception of the Grand Palace roof.

Following that, you will visit Wat Po, Bangkok's largest and oldest temple, as well as the temple that houses the world's largest single Buddha image: the Reclining Buddha (Phra Buddhasaiyas).

This temple is also regarded as the origin of Thai traditional massage.

Then we'll have lunch at a local restaurant before continuing on to Wat Arun, also known as the Temple of the Dawn and one of Bangkok's most well-known monuments and most widely published photos.

After this, we will take the local public express boat to Ratchawong pier, then take a vehicle transfer to Yaowarat Road where you will visit an interesting shop selling bird's nests and shark fins, continue to a very old tea shop to enjoy a cup of Chinese tea with the locals before heading down Trok Leng Moi EIA (a small alley) to Talad Kao for an interesting local market with a variety of fresh foods, fresh & dry fruits, Chinese herbs, and groceries.

Finally, walk to Wat Leng Neng Yee to explore the Taoist temple.

After that, we'll return to the hotel and spend the remainder of the day at our leisure.

DAY 3

Damnoen Saduk Floating market + boat ride + train market and local lunch

After breakfast, you can visit Damnoen Saduak Floating market.

Pick up from your hotel and then transfer to one of the most attractive floating markets of Thailand; the Damnoen Saduak Floating Market.

Here you will have the opportunity to take a long-tail boat tour to observe the lifeStyle of the local people along the small canals.

You will visit not only the coconut farm and have the chance to taste some delicious coconut juice, but also you will find a wonderful variety of seasonal fruits such as Rambutan, Mango, Papaya, etc. We will take you to train market and will let you spend time here until the train leaving the station to go back.

After lunch at a local restaurant, we will drive back to the hotel where you have the rest of the day is free at leisure to spend time relaxing or shopping.

Bangkok to Phuket by flight (Not included)

After breakfast, check out and transfer to the airport for your flight to Phuket.

Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check-in and overnight accommodation.

DAY 5

Phuket City tour with Big Budha

Get ready for a captivating Phuket city tour, including a visit to the iconic Big Buddha.

After breakfast at your hotel, you will be picked up by your guide and embark on a journey through the vibrant city of Phuket.

The tour will take you to various attractions, including Phuket Old Town, renowned for its charming Sino- Portuguese architecture and colorful shop-houses.

Next, you will visit the revered Wat Chalong Temple, a significant Buddhist site in Phuket.

Phi Phi island tour by join speed boat with local lunch including national park

The trip to Phi Phi Island will then begin.

Enjoy the Phi Phi Island Tour, a Thai island group located between the major island of Phuket and the Thai coast of the Malacca Strait.

Krabi Province governs the islands administratively.

The islands are usually reached by speedboats or long-tail boats from Krabi town or docks in Phuket Province.

During the late 1940s, Muslim fishermen settled on Phi Phi Don, which later became a coconut plantation.

The name Phi Phi (pronounced 'phi-phi') is Malay in origin.

Pulau Api-Api ('the fiery isle') was the ancient name for the islands.

The name is derived from the Pokok Api-Api, or 'fiery tree' (grey mangrove) that grows on the

islands.


